- [C] Who are we not to complain about? Each other Jm 5:9
- [D] Who are held up as examples of patience? The farmer, the prophets, and Job Jm 5:7; 10-11
- [E] What is the Lord full of? Compassion Jm 5:11. He is also merciful
- [F] According to 1 Thessalonians 5:14 we are to show patience to whom? Everyone
- [G] In Hebrews 12:1-3 remembering Christ's endurance on the cross should keep us from doing what?

- [H] In Hebrews 6:13-15 when did Abraham receive what was promised? After he patiently waited


