
Scripture Word Study: *Repentance* (Psalms 51)

- [21] Ps 51:14-17 | Matt 12:7 Have you offered God your broken heart? Do you show compassion?
- [22] Ps 51:18-19 | Psalm 122:6 Do you pray for the peace of Jerusalem? Why or why not?
- [23] Compare Psalm 51 with Hebrew 9:13-14. What did you learn?
